Our Pre-K children will have graduation photos taken (in the Narthex) on Friday, May 13th. The Preschool annual Beach Field Trip is on Wednesday, May 25th to the Edmonds Beach, and our last day of school is on Friday, JUNE 3rd.

Our weekly Bible lessons will teach about: "The Amazing Catch of Fish", "Breakfast on the Beach", "Jesus' Ascension", "Pentecost", and "Peter Teaches of Jesus." 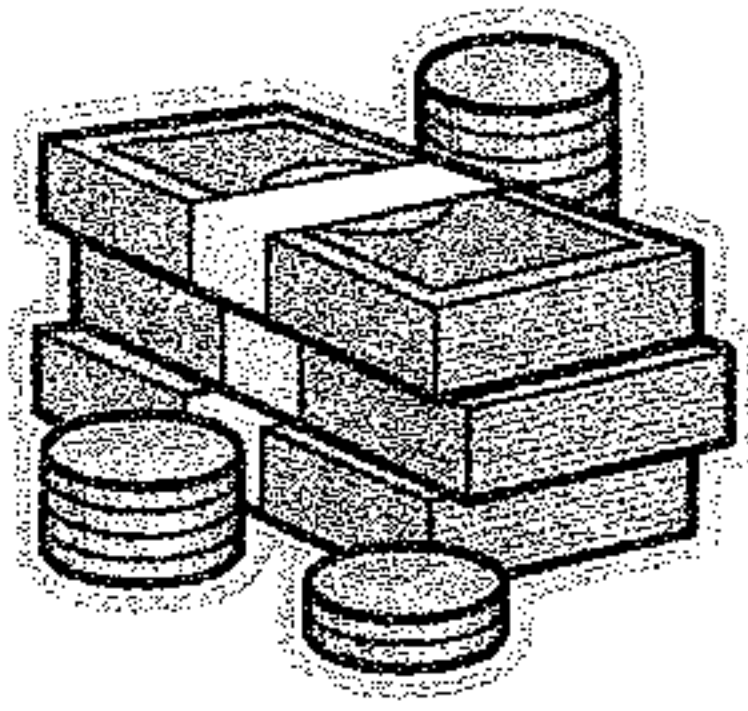

FINANCIAL REPORT - Mel Suelzle



March financial performance was not as strong as our normal 2011 trends. Service offerings were 70% of our plan for March, but still a respectable 95% for our fiscal year. Our mortgage donations were only sufficient to cover 67% of our mortgage payment. Preschool income is below plan due to lower than expected enrollment, but, expenses are also well below plan resulting in preschool income exceeding expenses by a small amount. Overall income exceeded expenses by over \$1600 for the March and \$26,013 for the 9 months of our current fiscal year.

Your Council is beginning the 2011/12 budget process. Planning by all of the groups is underway with preliminary budgets due at the May council meeting. Members are encouraged to share their thoughts as to how we set our priorities for our financial resources that God has given. Our schedule is to finalize the budget early June and present it for Voter approval on June 26th.

VOTER'S MEETING HIGHLIGHT'S – MARCH 13th

Amendments to the Synod Constitution were reviewed, discussed and both were voted to approve.

The Elders have completed the review of the membership rooster at STLC. Fred provided a list of members who will be removed from membership at STLC for various reasons. A vote was taken and it was approved to remove the former members from the rooster.

Mel provided information on the options to repair/clean the sanctuary roof and skylight. The motion was unanimously approved to reroof the entire skylight and provide other options for lighting in the sanctuary.

STLC received a request from Messiah Lutheran Church for a donation to assist Berhanu with legal cost for his green card and legal status in the US. A \$500 donation was approved by the voters.

Gary gave an update on the progress of the Call Committee. Pastor Rienke and Pastor Flath will be interviewed for the Pastor position at STLC.

Janet discussed the many opportunities available for Leadership at STLC. She asked everyone to prayerfully consider their roll at STLC.

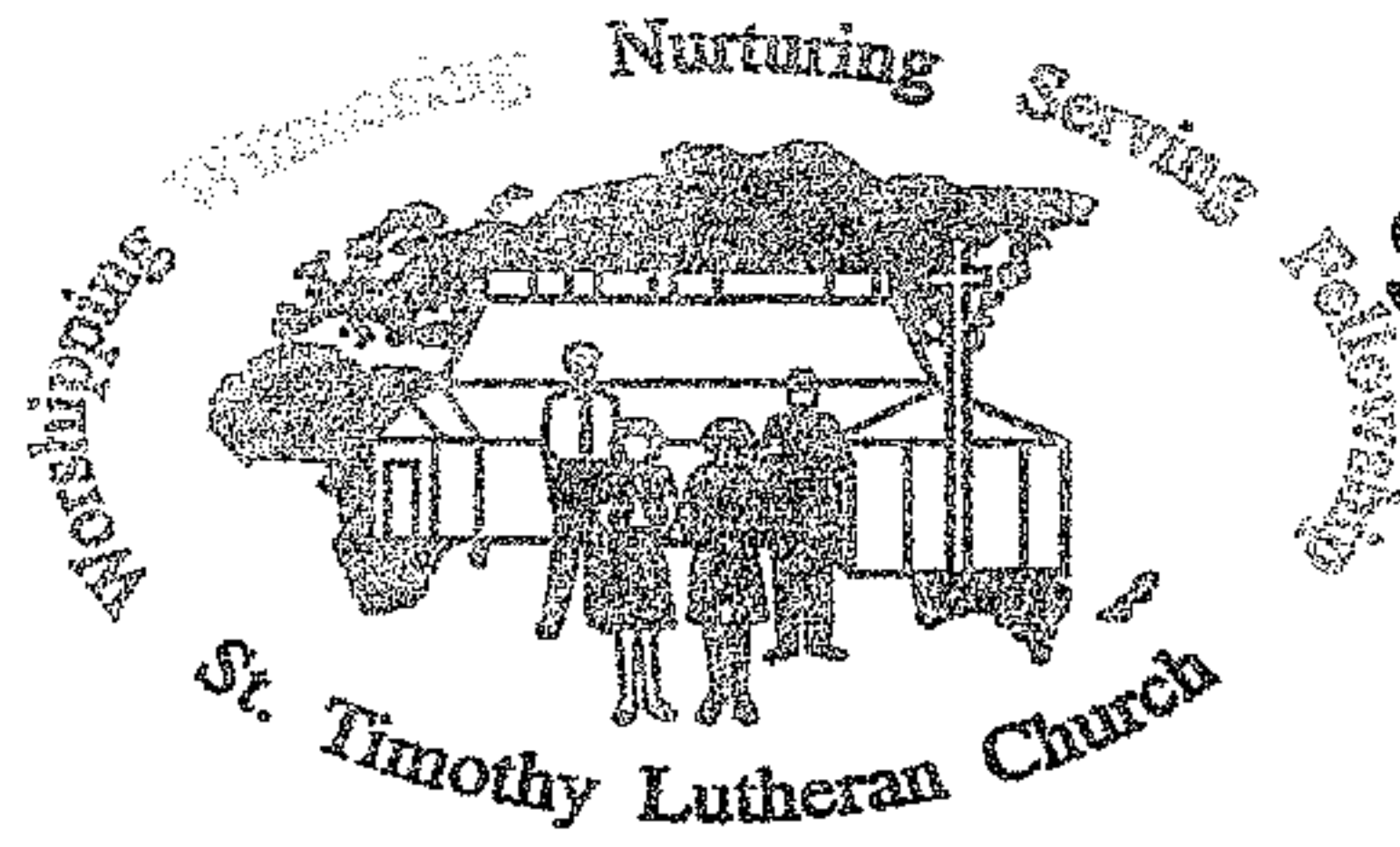
